

Charges and Remissions

The school may organise certain activities to support the curriculum which require us to ask for voluntary financial contributions. In accordance with The Education Reform Act 1988, no child will be stopped from taking part in an activity due to a lack of contribution from parents. However, it must be realised that without a reasonable level of response to these requests, future activities may not go ahead.

A voluntary contribution may be asked for:

- *Visiting theatre groups or performers*
- *Transportation for a range of outside activities*
- *Covering the cost of educational visits*
- *Food for school parties*
- *To support the School Fund and Governors Fund.*

A charge will be made for damage to property, books or equipment caused by pupil misbehaviour or lack of care. Individuals may be requested to pay a nominal contribution toward peripatetic music lessons. The school may seek support for fund raising events.
