


Weekly Home Learning



Then write the sentences – I can pack a bag. <u>Extra challenge!</u> Write the sentence – I pack socks in my back pack. - Don't forget to include your capital letter, finger spaces and full stop! Practise reading your sentence and draw a picture to go with it. - Remember to use cursive letter formation if you can! |

| | Story | Watch the story of sharing a shell. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6KuSI9eXgpk If you have the story at home it would be even more amazing to read it with your child. After listening to the story talk to your child about sharing. What kind of things do they like to share? Who do they like to share with? How does sharing make them feel? Explain that it is always important to share and be kind, just like characters in the story. |
