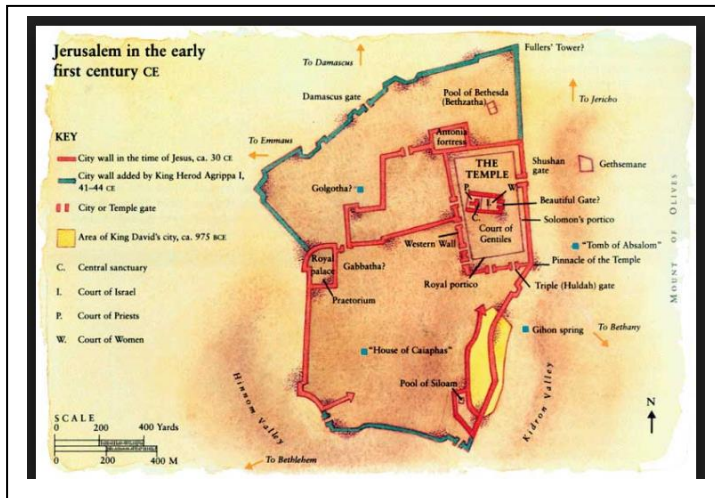

	<p>Well done you have finished the unit – Pentecost. We are now moving on to... <u>THE WORK OF THE APOSTLES</u> <u>V O C A B U L A R Y</u> Apostles, Book of Acts, Pentecost, Names of the Apostles.</p> <p><u>Task 1</u> What are the names of the apostles of Jesus? Discuss the content and the structure of the New Testament - Identify the names of the four Gospels? What do they record and discuss in detail (whose life)? Look at the Acts of the Apostles – can you see what some of the stories are about? Write a synopsis (summary) of three of the stories using no more than 100 words for each synopsis.</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Discuss what you have learned about Pentecost from your last three weeks of home learning and how the Apostles’ lives were changed by this event. What does the name “Apostle” mean? The Apostles of Jesus were sent out after Pentecost to preach the Good News of the Resurrection. Read the story of the preaching of Peter on the first Pentecost Sunday. Acts 3: 1-16 – The Beggar at the Beautiful Gate</p>

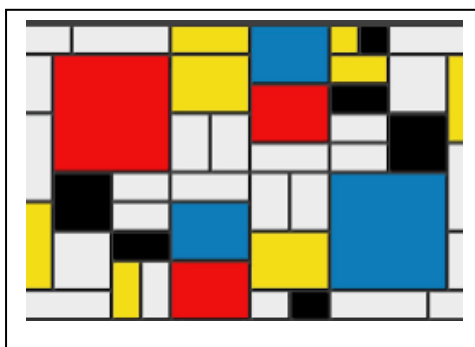
