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Free School Meals

Pupils in current Year 2 Pupils in our current year 2 class will not receive Universal Infant Free School Meals once they move up into Year 3 this September. However, you may qualify for free school meals, and if you do it's really important to apply in advance. See below for details of how to apply and the eligibility criteria.

For every child that is eligible for free school meals - we receive very valuable funding from the government called 'Pupil Premium Funding.' This funding is very precious and valuable and is always spent on improving the provision in school for the children. If you successfully apply for free school meals, you not only have the option to choose free school lunches for your child but you also bring in very precious funding for the school for the next 6 years

Contact Details



It is very important that school has the most up to date contact details of your telephone numbers. **If you have changed your contact details**, please pop into the office and let the school know. We want to ensure that we can contact you directly in the case of an emergency or if your child falls ill or has an injury at school during the school day.

ARBOR system

We use the system -ARBOR for all communications to you about school and updates of what's happening within School and to share updates. If you have not logged on Arbor as of yet, it is extremely important that you do.

Summer trips

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Online safety

As we are entering into the summer holidays it is important to talk to our children about keeping safe online.

Here are some key tips to help support your child's online safety:

- Talk regularly with your child about their online activities and who they interact with.
- Set clear boundaries around screen time and appropriate content.
- Use parental controls on devices and apps to help manage what your child can access and spot check your child's devices.
- Encourage critical thinking—help your child understand that not everything they see online is true or safe.
- Model good behaviour by demonstrating responsible and respectful online habits.

We also recommend visiting trusted websites such as ThinkUKnow, NSPCC Online Safety, and Childnet for further guidance and resources.



<u>Uniform</u>

• Children must wear smart, sensible, black school shoes/ trainers (or boots in winter) No bright coloured trainers, jelly shoes or shoes with a heel.
